IF- Intermediate Frequency

The Intermediate Frequency (IF) range is found above the low frequency range and below the range of most radio frequencies (RF). Human exposure to radiation and fields in this range has been uncommon until now, and therefore research in this area is still sparse.

In recent years the exposure to IF has been increasing, for example exposure to wireless electrical charging and induction cooktops. Therefore research interest in the possible health effects of exposure to this frequency range has increased.
